### Materials needed:

- Safe place to do arts and craft work
- Download the ark, rainbow and animals pages. Color all. Cut out only the rainbow and clouds.
- Glue stick and scotch tape
- Scissors

## **Science/Social Studies Connections:**

- -Rainbow experiment: Materials Clear glass or plastic bowl that a CD can sit half way into, water to fill half the bowl, a flashlight. Place the water in the bowl. Place the CD in the water on its edge, shiny side facing you. Shine the light on the CD and watch a rainbow appear. If these instructions are not clear, look it up on Pinterest under rainbows.
- \*\*Find several more ideas on Pinterest! I really like the Skittles one. And always go out to find the real rainbow after it rains!
  - -Study online what makes rainbows occur
  - -Paper plate ark: (Will show the finished product on the video)
    - -2 paper plates -markers/crayons or colored pencils -stapler -animal crackers




**<u>Bible Verses</u>**: "Noah found favor in the site of the Lord." Genesis 6:8 and "Noah obeyed God." Genesis 6:22

**Bible Text:** Genesis 6:8-22 (abridged) You, or an older child, read this portion. Ask questions. This is an excellent activity for a child to practice listening and/or reading comprehension, a language arts standard in the APS curriculum. Language arts = listening, speaking, reading and writing.

"But Noah found favor in the sight of the Lord. . . Noah walked with God, and Noah had three sons, Shem, Ham and Japeth. Now the earth was corrupt in God's sight and the earth was filled with violence. . . God said to Noah, 'I have determined to make an end to all flesh. . . Make yourself an ark of cypress wood; make rooms in the ark and cover it inside and outside with pitch (tar). This is how you are to make it: the length of the ark three hundred cubits, its width fifty cubits and it height thirty cubits. (A cubit is the length of a man's forearm, Noah's in this case, from his elbow to the tip of his longest finger.) Make a roof for the ark and finish it a cubit above. Put the door of the ark in its side. Make it with a lower, second and third decks. . .I am going to send a flood. . .And you shall come into the ark, you, your sons, your wife and your son's wives with you. And of every living thing, of all flesh, you shall bring two of every kind into the ark. . .They shall be male and female. . .Also take with you every kind of food that is eaten and store it up; and it shall serve as food for you and them. Noah did this; he did all that God commanded him."
