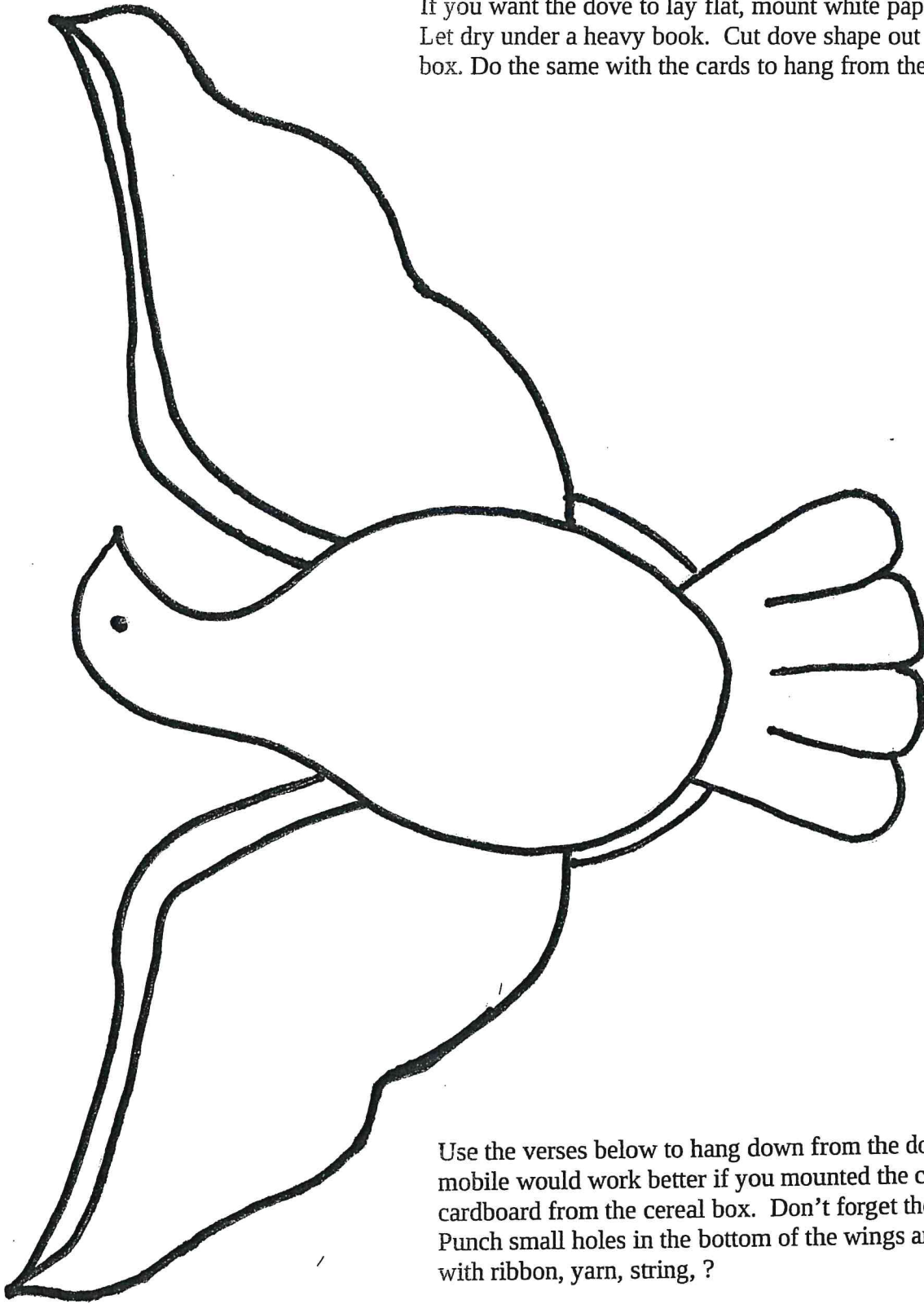

Dove Mobile Instructions:

Cut out dove picture. Mount on the large side of a cereal box. If you want the dove to lay flat, mount white paper on the back. Let dry under a heavy book. Cut dove shape out of the cereal box. Do the same with the cards to hang from the dove.
