Dear Families: This is a review of children's brain development in light of faith development. Children learn from families first, mostly through imitation. Bible Text:

Note: The Jews and Samaritans were neighbors who hated each other. Some think they were genetically related while others think the Samaritans had some Jewish blood but were "contaminated" by the blood and religions from mixed marriages with non-Jews. Whatever the truth of their actual heritage, the groups did not like each other, making this parable, a short story that teaches a moral or spiritual lesson, of The Good Samaritan hold more meaning. Jesus used many parables to teach the apostles and those who followed Him. The people of that time would have understood this parable in a deeper way. Also, there were many who tested Jesus to see if He spoke against the Law and Prophets. In Matthew 5:17-18 Jesus said very specifically, "Do not think that I have come to abolish the law or the prophets; I have come not to abolish but to fulfill. For truly I tell you, until heaven and earth pass away, not one letter, not one stroke of a letter, will pass from the law until all is accomplished."


"Just then a lawyer stood up to test Jesus, 'Teacher,' he said, 'what must I do to inherit eternal life?' He said to him, 'What is written in the law? What do you read there?' He answered, 'You should love the Lord with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself.' And He said to him, 'You have given the right answer; do this, and you will live.' But wanting to justify himself, he asked Jesus, 'And who is my neighbor?' Jesus replied, 'A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell into the hands of robbers, who stripped him, beat him, and went away, leaving him half dead. Now by chance a priest was going down that road; and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. So likewise a Levite, when he came to the place and saw him, passed by on the other side. But a Samaritan while traveling came near him; and when he saw him, he was moved with pity. He went to him and bandaged his wounds, having poured oil and wine on them. Then he put him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him. The next day he took out two denarii, gave them to the innkeeper, and said, 'Take care of him; and when I come back, I will repay you whatever more you spend.' Which of these three, do you think, was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of the robbers?' He said, 'The one who showed mercy.' Jesus said to him, 'Go and do likewise.'"






