Dear Families: Today's story is about a man who grew in wisdom, mostly because of the hardships he experienced in his life. He was very doted on as a child. This made his relationship with his brothers become really negative. To see how God turned his troubles into something that ending up saving his entire family can be inspiring. God Bless!

Bible Text: Genesis 37:1-36;

Jacob settled in the land where his father had lived . . . This is the story of the family of Jacob, , , Joseph, being 17, was shepherding the flock with his brothers . . . Now Israel (Jacob) loved Joseph more than any of his children because he was the son of his old age and he made him a long robe with sleeves. When his brothers saw that their father loved him more than all his brothers, they hated him . . Once Joseph had a dream and when he told it to them, they hated him even more . . . "Listen to this dream that I dreamed. We were binding sheaves in the field. Suddenly my sheaf rose and stood upright. Then your sheaves gathered around it and bowed down to my sheaf . . . The brothers said to him, "Are you indeed to reign over us?" So they hated him even more. . .He had another dream and told it to his brothers. . . The sun, the moon, and eleven stars were bowing down to me; but when he told it to his father and his brothers, his father rebuked him and said. . . "Shall we indeed come, I and your mother and your brothers and bow to the ground before you?" So his brothers were jealous of him, but his father kept the matter in mind. Later. . . Israel sent Joseph to his brothers, who were shepherding the flock. . .They saw him from a distance and before he came near they conspired to kill him. . .But Ruben, the oldest, (heard the brothers and intervened) ". . .throw him in this pit here but lay no hand on him" (He was going to come back later and rescue him.) So when Joseph came to his brothers, they stripped him of his robe. . .and threw him into a pit. Then they set down to eat and looking up they saw a caravan_of Ishmaelites. . .on their way to Egypt. . .they drew Joseph up out of the pit and sold him. . . for twenty pieces of silver. . .(Joseph was taken to Egypt and sold as a slave). . .When Reuben returned to the pit and saw that Joseph was not in the pit, he tore his clothes. . . They took Joseph's robe, slaughtered a goat and dipped the robe in the blood. . . They took the robe to their father and said, "This we have found; se now whether it is your son's robe or not." Then Jacob tore his garments and put sackcloth on. . .and mourned for his son many days.






