Dear Families:

Bible Text: Esther 2:5-23; 3:1-15 Abridged

(Ahasuerus, (Xerxes I) a Persian (Modern Day Iran) king, needed a wife. The king's servants gathered many women from the kingdom from whom he could choose.) Now there was a Jew in the citadel of Susa whose name was Mordecai. . . Mordecai had brought up Hadassah, that is Esther, his cousin, for she had neither father nor mother; the girl was fair and beautiful, and when her father and her mother died, Mordecai adopted her as his own daughter. So when the king's order and his edict were proclaimed. . . Esther was taken into the palace. . . Esther did not reveal her people or kindred, for Mordecai had charged her not to tell. . . Every day Mordecai would walk around the front of the court. . to learn how Esther was and how she fared. . . (After the preparation to be presented to the king). . . of all the women, she won his favor and devotion, so that he set the royal crown on her head and made her queen. . . Then the king planned a great banquet, Esther's banquet. . . When the women were being gathered together, Mordecai was sitting at the king's gate. . . two of the guards became angry and conspired to assassinate King Ahasuerus. . . Mordecai told Queen Esther and Esther told the king. Both men were (dealt with).

After these things the king promoted (a man named) Haman over the officials who were with him. All the servants who were at the king's gate bowed down to Haman. But Mordecai did not bow down (because Jews followed the 10 commandments that said not to bow down to anyone but God). . .Haman was infuriated. . .and thinking is was beneath him to lay hands on Mordecai, found out who his people were. Haman plotted to destroy all the Jews. . .Haman said to King Ahasuerus, "There is a certain people scattered and separated among peoples in all the provinces of your kingdom; their laws are different from those of every other people. The do not keep the king's laws, so that it is not appropriate for the king to tolerate them. If it pleases the king, let a decree be issued for their destruction, and I will pay ten thousand talents of silver into the hands of those who have charge of the king's business, so that they may put it into the king's treasuries." . . .(The king sent out a decree to all his kingdom, to destroy and annihilate all Jews.)


3rd and Up:




Esther the Queen Maze
