Realizing this goal includes preservation of traditional art forms, the repatriation of objects of cultural patrimony and the capacity to educate tribal members of the importance of preserving their cultural past for future generations. These are values that bind the Acoma People to their environment - to social, economic, and spiritual aspects of their lives. Acoma and its history, handed down from generation to generation, is the people's version of life experience - it interprets the worlds of past, present, and future.

As part of the plan to preserve the culture, pueblo leaders have invested in the construction of this unique facility to preserve the proud heritage of the Acoma people. The museum will also serve as a premier education and research institution with an emphasis on the preservation of Acoma history, the revitalization of lost art forms and retention of language.

The objective of the Cultural Center and Museum are to develop permanent and revolving exhibits, create and implement a Tribal Repatriation Policy for the return of cultural items, build educations and interpretive programs that will encourage both community involvement and expose visitors to the rich and unique heritage of Haak'u.
